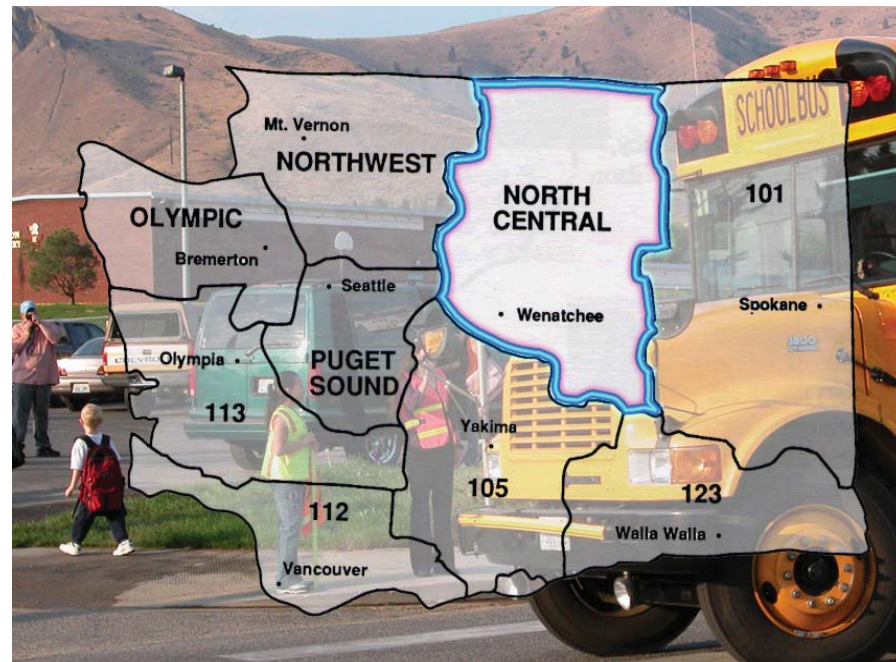
# Our Mission

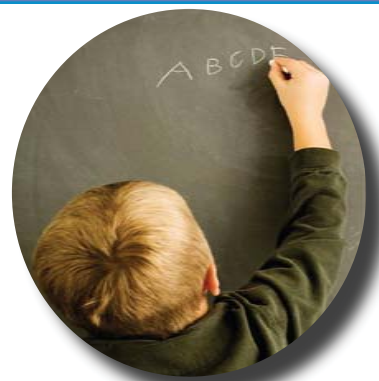
North Central ESD is one of nine ESDs in the State committed to working together as part of an ESD Network to provide quality services in a consistent manner no matter where a district is located or what services they require!

# North Central ESD

North Central Educational Service District is one of nine regional educational agencies serving school districts and state-approved private schools in Washington. ESDs are an essential regional delivery system for K-12 services in the state. We create regional efficiencies, improve the effectiveness of educational programs, deliver vital services otherwise unavailable, and bring millions of dollars in new funding to schools in our state.



# Our Funding

Our programs are funded primarily through entrepreneurial efforts. We apply for and receive competitive state, federal and private grants, and also operate cooperatives among schools and other agencies, supported through membership fees. In addition, we develop services for our region on a pay-for-service basis. We receive less than 4% of our revenue from the state. Funding sources include:

<b>State Allocation</b>	<b>4%</b>
<b>Co-ops</b>	<b>22%</b>
<b>Fees</b>	<b>21%</b>
<b>Grants</b>	<b>53%</b>



# Our Governance

North Central ESD is governed by a seven-member board, elected by local school directors. Each board member represents several school districts within the ESD region. Agency operations are overseen by Dr. Richard McBride, superintendent.

# Our Contributions to Schools and their Communities

In 2008-2009 North Central ESD leveraged over \$500,000 of core state funding allocated by the legislature into more than \$15 million of services for K-12 schools and students:

- **\$37 for every core state-funded dollar**
- **\$394 of service per student**

North Central ESD programs:

- Save schools money through cost-effective cooperatives, centralized services, and pooled resources.
- Provide specialized services otherwise unavailable.
- Secure new resources for the region.
- Provide leadership for innovative educational and administrative practices.
- Build networks and cooperative arrangements among districts and other agencies.
- Link schools with state and national educational resources.
- Serve as a liaison between schools and the OSPI and other agencies.
