"I became interested in science as a young child through involvement in after school and summer nature programs and interactions with the science staff at a museum (Newark Museum, Newark, NJ). For college, I chose to go to the Rutgers University in New Brunswick where I studied the ecology of salamanders for my master's (1957) and doctorate (1959) degrees. Although most women ended their graduate work with the master's degree, there was no prohibition against going on for the doctorate. I was strongly motivated to earn the doctorate because I wanted to pursue my own research interests."
