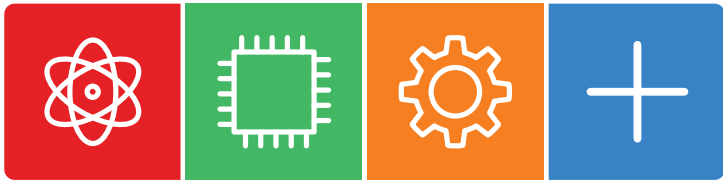




Mark your calendars for the 2nd-Annual



NCESD STEM SUMMIT

The 2nd-Annual STEM Summit will be held on August 13-16 at the Wenatchee Convention Center.

This event will highlight multiple professional learning opportunities for teachers and educational staff members in the areas of science, technology, engineering and mathematics taught by experts and specialists in their fields. The NCESD is currently accepting Presenter Applications.

Each day will begin with a keynote speaker and offer over 50 breakout sessions over the course of 4 days. 24 STEM Clock Hours will be offered for purchase and lunch will be provided each day.

Celebrate National School Nurse Day on May 9th

School nurses optimize student health and learning every day of the year. But, on National School Nurse Day, we take special time to celebrate and recognize the contributions that school nurses are making to the health and learning of our nation's 50 million children.

School nurses advocate for students' health and safety at district and state policy levels. These policies include: safe medication storage and administration, evidence-based 'too-sick-for-school' guidelines, high nutritional standards for school meals, appropriate physical education and recess times, involvement in school attendance teams, and promotion of trauma informed care supporting students with mental health concerns.

Students with chronic and acute health conditions can have their health needs met at school because of their school nurse's clinical assessment, judgement, and planning. School staff are trained by school nurses to understand emergency signs and symptoms, and when and how to get help, allowing maximum in-class time for students who require medical interventions.
