# Adding Intentional Teaching Experiences to your weekly plan:

The *Intentional Teaching Experiences* describe playful and engaging experiences that can be implemented throughout the day, typically during small-group time, and include directions to help teachers individualize each experience to meet the needs of every learner. Designed specifically for use in the kindergarten classroom, these experiences support learning in the key areas of math and literacy, and encourage children's physical and social–emotional development.

- While in the Teach area (1), select Week on the top navigation menu (2).
- Select one or more of the same Time of Day from your weekly template (3) **or** select Add an Activity (4) and one or more day of the week (5). Then select Next (6).
  - For kindergarten classes, you can select Large Group, Learning Station, Individual Child Plan, Small Group, Outdoor Experiences, Indoor Group Experiences, or custom times of day.

### Using MyTeachingStrategies® Family


#### **Step 4: Share Distance Learning Plans**


