WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE AN ON THE JOB INJURY



Do you need medical attention?



If emergency medical care is needed, CALL 911 immediately <u>and</u> have someone notify your Supervisor

*Your Supervisor or someone from the District Office will make arrangements to get the WC paperwork to you.

If emergency care is NOT needed, report the incident to your supervisor and complete the Employee Incident Report.

*Send to District Office

Before going to the doctor, obtain a WC Claims Packet from building or District Office

Leave the completed SIF-2 & the Supplement to the SIF-2 forms at District Office

Take SIF-2 (pink copy), PIR, & PCE form to your doctor's appointment

Return to District Office immediately following all appointments with the PCE or APF, plus any notes from your doctor releasing or any restrictions

If your doctor restricts you from work you will receive a phone call from the Claims Manager at Tristar Risck Management

Investigation of <u>ALL</u> claims is a normal part of the WC claims management process.

You may:

- > Receive additional forms by mail to complete.
- ➤ Have a recorded statement taken.
- Be scheduled for an IME.

Report the incident to your supervisor immediately and fill out the Employee Incident Report form together *Send to District Office

No additional paperwork is required at this time

*If you need medical attention in the future, please follow the steps on the left side of this process

District Office:

★ Send claim to NCESD for handling by Tristar Risk Management

(SIF-2, supplement to SIF-2, PCE, APF, doctor notes and in house Employee Incident Report)

★ Notify NCEDS if employee is unable or does not return to work
